

**COVID 19 CORONAVIRUS POLICY**  
**MANAGING THE SPREAD OF THE VIRUS**

As a Church we take seriously the threat of this world wide pandemic. We also believe the Church should be responsible and ensure we actively support the trust our community place in us.

- Our Sunday morning service will continue, however we ask that no physical contact be made. No hand shaking, no embracing.
- In the event you have a cough, sneeze, headache, a high temperature or any sign of being unwell that can be linked to the virus, we ask you not attend.
- We also ask that anyone that is unwell, to contact the Pastor, who will pray for you
- Masks will be available as you enter, however not mandatory .
- Anyone entering the building will be required to use the hand sanitiser .
- There will be no childrens Sunday school and ask parents to keep their children with them
- Our fellowship afterward is an important element of our meeting; due to the size of our side room where we meet for tea and coffee, we will not be congregating there as usual but encourage fellowship in the main auditorium.
- Anyone working in the kitchen will be required to wear gloves and we ask that no home made food be brought to the service. Only pre wrapped and packaged food from the supermarket.
- Only disposable plates, cups and cutlery will be used.
- We will maintain communion with the elements of the bread and cup being offered according to proper hygiene standards.
- Our chairs will be wiped prior and after every service and we ask that you bring your own pen should you want to write notes.

We are a Christ centred Church and believe that fear has no place in the Believers life. Our policy is not from a place of fear, but a place of trust and honouring the instructions given to us by our Government and health authorities to implement
